All Are Needed

CALWORKS PROPOSALS

- Budget Request to fund CalWORKs Grants
- AB 1436 (Stone) & Budget Request to restore power of CalWORKs Earned Income Disregard
- Budget Request 60 Mo CalWORKs Lifetime limit
- SB 268 (Wiener) End Asset Test
- AB 807 (Bauer-Kahan) to CalWORKs income
- AB 268 (Chiu) CalWORKs penalties
- AB 944 (Quirk) Immigrant Sponsor Deeming

- AB 1377 (Wicks) School Nutrition & CalFresh
- AB 1499 (McGuire) Expands funds for Universal Free Breakfast
- AB 1022 (Wicks) & Budget Ask ABAWD CalFresh
- AB 987 (Rivas) CalWORKs Nutrition Supplement
- AB 842 (Limón & Eggman) Pre-K Nutrition
- AB 534 (Mayes) Comprehensive Hunger Plan
- 1229 (Wicks) Former Foster Youth - Hunger



TAX CREDITS & INCOME SUPPORT

- AB 1593 (Gomes-Reyes) Ending immigrant worker exclusion in EITC
- AB 24 (Burke) & Budget Act Creating the Targeted Child Tax Credit (TCTC)
- AB 1682 (Wicks) Caregiver Tax Credit
- AB 1434 (Kalra) SSI Cost of Living

CHILD CARE

- SB 321 (Mitchell) CalWORKs Stage Two Child Care
- AB 378 (Limón) would will allow 40K+ early childhood educators to join care providers in 11 other states who are able to join a union
- SB 365 (Durazo) would expedite access to CalWORKs Child Care
- Blue Ribbon Task Force Bills
- Budget Requests
