By supporting educators' professional growth in understanding the importance of their role when caring for infants and toddlers, we are supporting the development of all children.

The purpose of the Contra Costa Quality Matters Areas of Specialization in Early Childhood Education for Family Child Care Educators is to build capacity within QM sites through equitable means while empowering our educators to become lifelong learners in the field of early care and education.

The specialization has two parts: 1) the PITC course and 2) a minimum of 7 hours of other training
