Completion of select inclusion-related professional development (PD) opportunities qualify the attendee for a shopping pass to support inclusive classroom environments.

- The shopping pass, worth \$600, can be used to purchase classroom materials from a pre-selected retailer. More details on eligible classroom materials will be provided upon completion.
- Only one shopping pass can be awarded per child care site for this program year and it must be used before June 15, 2025. While supplies last.

In order to qualify for this shopping pass, you must:

1. Be an educator, director, or site supervisor currently employed at a licensed and operating Child Care Center or Family Child Care Home (FCCH) located in Contra Costa County.
2. Have registered for and completed one of the select trainings, workshops, or other PD opportunities related to inclusive ECE classrooms. Full attendance at the selected eligible opportunity is a requirement.
3. Complete a short evaluation of the PD opportunity that you attended.
Access to this evaluation will be provided at the conclusion of the training or workshop.

Eligible purchases are those from a pre-selected list of items at this retailer. Additional details will be provided to you once you are given access.

2. The attendee must be an educator, director, or site supervisor currently employed at a licensed and operating Child Care Center or Family Child Care Home (FCCH) located in Contra Costa County.
3. Shopping passes are only available while supplies last.
