CHILDREN CLASSES

VIRTUAL CLASSES VIA ZOOM:

Phonics Train (3 years) VIRTUA

Phonics train is a class designed to teach young learners the fundamentals of reading by focusing on letter-sound relationships. This approach aims to build a strong foundation for reading and spelling.

Reading with Me (3 years) VIRTUAL

The objective of this class is to promote early literacy and encourage daily reading in children.

What's in the Ocean? (4 years) VIRTUAL
This virtual class takes a deep dive into the ocean to explore the creatures that live there through storytimes and art activities.

Me on the Map (4 years to 5 years)

Welcome to this OFFSITE class which will be held at different locations around our city of Pittsburg every week. Class confirmation emails will include the locations of the 6 weeks.

IN-PERSON CLASSES:

Little Melanin Movers: A Tummy Time Experience (3 weeks to 6 months) ONLY FOR AFRICAN-AMERICAN FAMILIES

Little Melanin Movers: A Tummy Time Experience is a culturally grounded infant wellness class created just for African American families. Designed for babies ages 0 to 6 months, this class celebrates Black joy, growth, and movement by centering the importance of tummy time — a foundational building block for motor skills, strength, and early development.

Masaje Infantil (6 weeks to 5 months) SPANISH ONLY

Class taught by a certified infant massage instructor. The first week parents will receive information about the importance and benefits of infant massage. The next 5 weeks a series of fun and loving massages are carefully incorporated in order to help parents develop a deeper bond with their babies and perhaps benefit their health, development and emotional health.

Fall Wonderland (1 year)

How can we have fun during the Fall? In this class we are going to explore fun activities for the Fall season.

Lee y Canta (1 year) <u>SPANISH ONLY</u>
Practicing Spanish. Let's explore the first steps of reading and singing! In this class, we'll explore many books and other activities focused on fun topics.

Let's Move (1 year)

Come and move along with your child while exploring additional gross motor age-appropriate activities that can be practiced at

Playing Together (1 year)

Children will do a variety of hands-on activities that parents can continue at home with their child by using different home materials.

Toddler Fun Zone (1 year)

In this class we will explore many fun activities in order to practice many important skills like problem solving, exploring and socializing, followed by fine and gross motor skills.

Aprendiendo Juntos (2 years) SPANISH ONLY

How do we play together? In this class, we'll practice the basics of using space, sharing toys, and continuing to build important skills for this stage of development.

Dinosaur Discovery (2 years)

Fantastic Fine Motor (2 years)

In this class children will focus on developing and improving the ability to use small muscles in the hands, finger, and wrist for precise movements. Great to inhale coordination and control . which are essential for tasks like writing,drawing, cutting and

manipulating objects.

Math Stars (2 years)

Come and build your foundation of early math skills. Exploring multiple activities, we will be learning about shapes, numbers and other early math concepts.

Messy Days (2 years)

Let's play with an age-appropriate, kid-friendly messy activity and we will see children have fun in this class.

My 5 Senses (2 years)

This class is designed to introduce young learners to the world through their senses. By having engaging activities, children will explore sound, smell, taste, sight and touch.

Terrific Toddlers (2 years)

In this class we will explore many fun activities in order to practice many important skills like problem-solving, exploring and socializing.

Toddler Wobbler (2 years)

This class will focus on developing foundational skills such as motor skills, language development and sensory exploration in a nurturing environment through supervised play and ageappropriate activities.

African Americans and the Arts (2 years to 5 years)

African American artists have long shaped the cultural landscape through powerful and innovative expressions of identity, history, and creativity. This class invites you and your family to explore the rich legacy of African American art, celebrating a wide range of artists, styles, and movements. Together, we'll dive into the stories behind their work, discover the meaning behind their techniques, and enjoy hands-on art activities inspired by their contributions.

Pete the Cat Adventures (2 years to 5 years)

Pete the Cat books work with children to assist with problem-solving, emphasis on calm reactions, developing vocabulary, and many more. Let's explore the books together!! Book Craft (3 years)

Books encourage language skills, expression of emotions and exposing children to new words. We will read a new book every week and work on crafts based on the book.

Creative Corner (3 years)

What can you create? In this class we will explore our creativity. Each class will provide an opportunity to practice and learn many skills in a fun way while creating art.

Eric Carle Adventures (3 years)

Let's embark on a vibrant journey into the world of Eric Carle, reading and exploring his iconic books.

Reading Together (3 years)

The objective of this class is to encourage daily reading in children. Also in class the children will share which was their favorite book of the week. And the activities of the class will be appropriate to their age supporting the best development of all their activities.

What's in the Garden? (3 years)

This class invites families to explore the wonders of nature through a variety of activities, projects and stories. In this class we will be using our indoor classroom as well as our outside space. Under the Sea (3 years)

We will explore under the sea creatures, plants and habitats while working on a 6 week build-up age-appropriate craft.

Afro Alphabet Adventures Part II
