Art Adventures - Fridays

(In Person) 3-5yrs

In this class, children will have the opportunity to engage with different materials and explore their creating side. Then we will practice sharing what they create with others.

Bridge to Kindergarten – Wednesdays – <u>CLASS FULL</u>

(In Person) 4-5yrs

Children and parents will begin to learn the skills that will be necessary to be ready for school. Activities will directly coincide with the California standards for kindergarten. This class begins in the Fall and continues through the spring.

Bright & Beyond - Mondays

(In Person) 1-2yrs

This class will demonstrate how to use the Bright & Beyond activity cards at home with your child. Bright & Beyond activity cards encourage children's development with easy, enjoyable parent and child activities. The cards provide intriguing, age specific activities that promote thinking, coordination, creativity, and more by using simple, everyday items that families already have at home.

Count & Match with Ms. Bernice - Tuesdays

(In Person) 3-5yrs

Parents and caretakers will explore and engage with their children in a fundamental way of learning and matching numbers and colors while children enhance their memory skills through using everyday materials.

Danzability - Wednesdays

(In Person) 3 yrs

In this class children and families will get a chance to explore different types of dances from all around the world for any abilities. This class will be offered bilingual and will engage families to explore their physical skills through movement.

Help Me Grow - Tuesdays

(In Person) By Referral Only

This developmental playgroup is designed to assist children who have been identified as needing additional support through their ASQ (Ages & Stages Questionnaire). Individuals will be contacted by the Center and offered opportunities to participate in this playgroup. If you have further questions, please contact a Community Resource Specialist.

Jump Bunch - Fridays

(In Person) 2-3yrs

This class will engage children in the development of their gross motor skills while practicing sequencing patterns and group work by introducing the to play organized sport activities.

Kinder Readiness - Wednesdays

(In Person) 4-5yrs

Parents will gain insightful information about the desirable readiness skills that will help their child get off to a good start when they begin school.

Ready for Learning – Thursdays

(In person) 3yrs

Children will be introduced to the concepts of colors, shapes, and letters. Research shows that children who learn a second language exhibit better problem-solving skills, language development, and overall success in school.

Super Saturday Surprise Class - Saturdays

(In person) 2-5 yrs

Join us for our Super Saturday Surprise Class! Each week brings a new fun-filled activity for parents and children ages 2–5 to enjoy together. From creative crafts to playful games - you never know what exciting surprise awaits!

Terrific Toddlers - Tuesdays

(In Person) 2yrs

Kids will explore the world through their senses. Focusing on the process, not the product, as children discover colors, textures, and sounds through art.

Car Seat 101 - Thursdays

(In Person) Adults

Car Seat 101 provides basic education on correct use of car seats, booster seats, seat belts and vehicle safety systems which can help save lives and prevent injury and death. It will be divided into focused sections (rear-facing car seats, forward-facing car seats, booster seats and seat belts).

Nurturing Parents (Spanish) - Tuesdays

(In person) Adults

This class is for families with children ages 0–5 and focuses on building positive daily routines at home. Using the Picture Exchange Communication System (PECS), children learn to express their needs through pictures while parents create supportive, structured routines. The goal is to encourage communication, positive behavior, and language development in young children.

Road Map to Kindergarten - Wednesdays - <u>CLASS FULL</u> (In Person) Adults

This class is designed to help parents prepare for their child's transition to Kindergarten. Parents will receive a Road Map of the year that will help increase their knowledge of child development and school readiness. This class begins in the Fall and continues through the spring.
