Art Adventures - Tuesdays

(In Person) 3yrs

In this class, children will have the opportunity to engage with different materials and explore their creating side. Then we will practice sharing what they create with others.

Bridge to Kindergarten – Wednesdays – CLASS FULL

(In Person) 4-5yrs

Children and parents will begin to learn the skills that will be necessary to be ready for school. Activities will directly coincide with the California standards for kindergarten. This class begins in the Fall and continues through the spring.

Bright & Beyond for Babies - Wednesdays

(In Person) 6-12mos

This class will demonstrate how to use the Bright & Beyond activity cards at home with your baby. Bright & Beyond activity cards encourage children's development with easy, enjoyable parent and baby activities. The cards provide intriguing, age specific activities that promote thinking, coordination, creativity, and more by using simple, everyday items that families already have at home.

Count with Me - Fridays

(In Person) 2-3yrs

Engaging the parent/caregiver in having comfort and a better understanding on how to incorporate math in the child's everyday life. Enriching fun math and reading that encourages counting, reading and movement while embracing love for literacy.

Danzability – Wednesdays

(In Person) 2-3yrs

In this class children and families will get a chance to explore different types of dances from all around the world for any abilities. This class will be offered bilingual and will engage families to explore their physical skills through movement.

Let's Count & Match with Ms. Bernice – Tuesdays

(In Person) 3-5yrs

Parents and caretakers will explore and engage with their children in a fundamental way of learning and matching numbers and colors while children enhance their memory skills through using everyday materials.

Music Makers - Wednesdays

(In Person) 3yrs

In this class we will create musical instruments, learn a bit about using those instruments and build on a love for music through rhythm and melodies. Children will discover how music is all around them.

Preschool Time – Mondays

(In Person) 3-4yrs

This class will provide quick, fun and creative tools to enhance your child's development and to strengthen the special bond with your preschool child.

Smart Bites - Fridays

(In Person) 3-5yrs

In this class children will learn about healthy plates. They will have the opportunity to prepare healthy meals and then they will taste.

Spring Science - Thursdays

(In Person) 3-4yrs

Families will learn about the science involved in the change of seasons. We will learn more about changes to nature.

Story Time & Art – Tuesdays

(In Person) 2-3yrs

This class consists of story time, group discussion, class participation, and a chance to role play all in one.

Super Surprise Saturday Class - Saturdays

(In Person) 2-5 yrs

Join us for our Super Saturday Surprise Class! Each week brings a new fun-filled activity for parents and children ages 2–5 to enjoy together. From creative crafts to playful games, you never know what exciting surprise awaits.

Terrific Toddlers – Mondays

(In Person) 2yrs

Kids will explore the world through their senses. Focusing on the process, not the product, as children discover colors, textures and sounds through art.

Wiggly Ones – Thursdays

(In Person) 1yr

This art and movement program will help your child build fine motor skills, hand/eye coordination, emotional skills, problem solving, intellectual skills, creative thinking when executing a project, and learning how to follow directions.

Zumbini - Fridays

(In Person) 2-3 yrs

The class includes dancing, singing, and playing different instruments to get exposure to music and all its benefits. This class introduces the basic moves like moving side to side, clapping, bouncing, jumping, toe touches, etc.

Finding Calm in the Chaos – Saturdays

(Virtual) Adults

In this class, parents and caregivers will have an opportunity to learn about mindfulness and how using these tools can help them navigate parenting and care for themselves.

Primero Nuestros Niños (Spanish) – Thursdays

(In Person) Adults

Road Map to Kindergarten – Wednesdays - CLASS FULL

(In Person) Adults

This class is designed to help parents prepare for their child's transition to kindergarten. Parents will receive a Road Map of the year that will help increase their knowledge of child development and school readiness. This class begins in the Fall and continues through the spring.

(In Person) Adults

This is an adult class focused on mental and emotional well-being. Through guided discussions and practical tools, participants will learn how to manage stress, strengthen their mindset, and care for their overall well-being to live a healthier life. **Sessions in Spanish.**

Triple P Stepping Stones on Zoom – Thursdays

(Virtual) Adults

This is a positive parenting program. In this class you will learn how to discipline your child, the tough part of parenting, establish a positive learning environment using assertive discipline.

CAC Focus Group – March 17

(In Person) Adults

The CAC Focus Group is a space for First 5 Center families to share their voices. Together, we will talk about the needs of our First 5 community and explore the Five Protective Factors that support strong families. What is shared will be used as data to help the CAC create recommendations to better support the center and the families it serves.
