Eric Carle Adventures – Mondays

(In person) 3yrs

Join us as we explore the colorful world of Eric Carle through stories, art, music, and hands-on activities. Children will build early literacy, creativity, and social skills while bringing beloved books to life through play and imagination.

Baby Signs, Spanish & English– Mondays & Tuesdays

(In person) 8-18 months

An interactive play group that will help parents and children learn useful signs, songs, and games. Through singing, dancing, and activities that highlight important developmental skills, parents and kids will begin singing right away.

Baby Sensory– Mondays

(In person) 1yrs

In this class, we will work on age-appropriate multi-sensory activities that are designed to encourage babies with their tactile, visual, and auditory stimulation.

Let's Count & Match with Ms. Bernice – Mondays

(In person) 3-5yrs

Parents and caretakers will explore and engage with their children in a fundamental way of learning and matching numbers and colors while children enhance their memory skills through using everyday materials.

Collage Making– Tuesdays

(In person) 2yrs

Toddlers will explore colors, textures, and shapes while creating fun collages with a variety of materials. A playful art experience that encourages creativity and fine motor skill development.

Little Scientist – Tuesdays

(In person) 4-5yrs

Get ready to mix, splash, explore, and create! In this class, children will explore the topic of science, build fine motor skills, and creative thinking through hands-on experiments and art projects.

Big Letters, Small Letters – Wednesdays

(In person) 4-5yrs

The class focus will be recognizing uppercase and lowercase letters through songs and activities.

Songs, Stories & Signs – Wednesdays & Fridays

(In person) 3-5yrs

In this class we will read stories and sing songs that will help build a love for literacy while learning some signs to go along with the books and songs. This will help encourage communication skills in a variety of ways.

Colors – Wednesdays

(In person) 2yrs

This class, we will work on age-appropriate multi-sensory activities that introduce and reinforce color recognition through play. This includes sorting objects by color, creating art with different colored material, and using everyday items to identify and name colors.

Bright & Beyond – Thursdays

(In person) 1-2yrs

This class will demonstrate how to use the Bright & Beyond activity cards at home with your child. Bright & Beyond activity cards encourage children's development with easy, enjoyable parent and child activities. The cards provide intriguing, age specific activities that promote thinking, coordination, creativity, and more by using simple, everyday items that families already have at home.

Scissor Skills – Thursdays

(In person) 3yrs

Children will practice safe scissor use through fun cutting activities, crafts, and games. This class helps build fine motor skills, hand strength, and confidence while creating simple projects.

Ready for Learning, English & Spanish – Thursdays

(In person) 3yrs

In this class children will be introduced to concepts of colors, shapes and letters. They will build on skills such as writing, cutting and working with others.

Tummy Time & Music – Fridays

(In person) 6-12months

This class will give you the opportunity to spend some time with your child doing tummy time. Tummy time helps to strengthen muscles in the neck, back, arms, shoulders, and

legs. You will get the chance to connect with other families while participating in various activities.

Book Adventures – Fridays

(In person) 3 years

A playful introduction to books with stories, songs, and sensory play. Designed for babies and caregivers to enjoy early literacy together.

Super Surprise Saturday – Saturdays

(In person) 2-5yrs

Join us for our Super Saturday Surprise Class! Each week brings a new fun-filled activity for parents and children ages 2–5 to enjoy together. From creative crafts to playful games, you never know what exciting surprise awaits.
