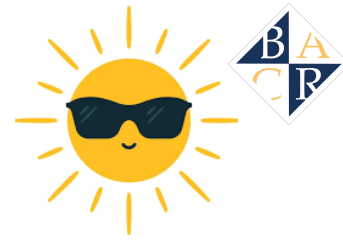

CHILD CLASSES

BABY SIGNS (0-12m)

Introduce your baby to simple sign language to help them communicate needs and feelings—reducing frustration while building early connection.

MUSIC FOR ME (0-12m)

Sing, move, and play! Little ones explore music through songs, instruments, and joyful movement.

WIGGLE WORM (12-23m)

An active class where toddlers build confidence, coordination, and listening skills through fun movement and play.

GENIOS CURIOSOS (12-23m) *SPANISH*
